

**IMPORTANT NOTES FOR APPLICANTS:**

1. Preference shall be given to those candidates who secured a good percentile in CUET (2026).

2. Those students who have not appeared in CUET (2026) may also be considered on merit basis/through Entrance Test as per RGU/Govt. guidelines only if vacancies exist after allowing admission to all those applicants who qualified CUET (2026).
3. Candidates who have passed class XII examination in 2026 with English as one of the subjects from any recognized Board are eligible. Cases of class XII passed in 2025 may be considered subject to production of a Gap Certificates (declaring not admitted in any institute during the last academic session) from the competent authority.
4. Online application form can be submitted at the website [www.dngc.ac.in](http://www.dngc.ac.in) as per the above schedule.
5. Admission will be done purely on the basis of merit and as per the other relevant criteria.
6. A student of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com I semester has to study one Major Course along with one Minor Course, one Multidisciplinary Course (MDC), one Ability Enhancement Course (AEC), one Skill Enhancement Course (SEC), and one Value Added Course (VAC) (Total 6 subjects - Refer to online prospectus).
7. The applicants are advised to read the procedure of online application/instructions in the online portal <https://dngc.amli.in/admission.php> or <https://dngc.ac.in/> before filling up the forms.
8. The **Academic Bank of Credit (ABC ID)** is a mandatory field in online admission form. The applicants must register for ABC ID (if not already registered) from the link <https://www.digilocker.gov.in/> and click on the **Sign Up** button for creation of a Digilocker account. The applicants may watch the ABC ID creation process in the link <https://youtu.be/Gw3DUHa1g1c>.
9. Once the applicant is selected, s/he has to pay admission fee online and submit the hardcopies of all relevant documents as per the time schedule mentioned above.
10. The admission for **Third, Fifth & Seventh Semester** shall be held from 6<sup>th</sup> August 2026 to 10<sup>th</sup> August 2026. In view of limited space in classrooms, no candidate from other colleges will be entertained for admission in Third, Fifth & Seventh Semester.
11. For definition of Catchment and Open/Non-Catchment, applicants are directed to read prospectus carefully before filling up the online admission form. Prospectus is available at <https://dngc.ac.in/prospectus/>
